

GEM COUNTY ROD & GUN CLUB MEETING MINUTES

NOVEMBER 13, 2017

7:00 PM meeting called to order by President Trebby.

There was a motion to approve the October 9th, 2017 meeting minutes by Caleb Hoobery and seconded by Dean Wells. Vote was unanimous and minutes approved.

Correspondence: Boy Scouts asked to use the range this next upcoming Saturday. Usually 2 week notice is required. Brad Newell said they could use Rifle bay #4 if the board approves the short notice request. Brad made the motion to let the Boy Scouts train this next coming Saturday and it was seconded by Wells; motion carries.

TREASURER REPORT: Checking \$21,555.77, Savings \$16,048.09, Key Bank 650.00. Members to date for 2018 are 460. Gold and Silver holding are \$45,093.95/\$35,034.64

The board had decided that in January 2018 the club will publish a year end physical report concerning the Gold and Silver holdings. This will be on GCRGC website and January meeting minutes that also gets published on the website.

Brad Newell got a club debit card and Shannon Wells will secure it.

Charles Gull was sent a registered letter on what the board had decided about him canceling his membership check and still keeping his membership card. Caleb stated the club needs to charge him for the cost of the registered letter as well as other monies the club had to spend to take care of this matter.

Federal Government gave the club a bill for \$2K for not filing on time. Accountant Trudy said it was an error and will be corrected once the proper documents catch up to the tax filing. State of Idaho accepted everything and gave the club back \$190.

RANGE STATUS:

Brad Newell reports that everything is going well with the range. The trash service handled by Jim Bunting has been working out great. Jim Bunting did report he needed trash bags. Brad said he would take care of it.

Brad Newell and Dean Wells will be taking a look at the signs concerning shooting of steel targets on the pistol range. There will be possible new locations for the signs and a few slight changes in wording for better understanding on the distance needed away from the steel to safely shoot. President Trebby will be joining them.

Range Waiver Information: Shannon Wells reports that there will soon be an appropriate lockable box installed at the range for the mandatory waivers for guests/non-members at the firing range. All is needed now is a shrunk down copy of the waiver to go into the box. This box will not be used for paying annual membership fees. Brad Newell stated that for shoots there can be just one waiver with multiple lines for signatures. Waiver is good for the calendar year.

IT Committee: Chad said there will be an official IT meeting held after things slow down after the holidays.

Regulations of the Club: There will be changes made to the regulations of the GCRGC to correct or add to the verbiage to update the policies concerning defining commercial use of the gun range as well as membership. These changes will be posted in the newspaper December 11th says Brad Newell. This will be the required public notification.

GemTech will be getting notification of the change in commercial use of the range regulations after public notification and adaptation of the new bylaws.

Keycard for gun range gate: Nothing new concerning keycards for the front gate of the range. We are still waiting to see if Idaho Power can run electricity to the range.

Gun Range Bridge: President Trebby says everything is nailed down as far as the deal with the bridge and we should get a copy of the agreement soon with all right of ways in place for passage to the range over the bridge.

Motion: To hold off on the sub-committee meeting concerning family membership and Gold/Silver holdings until the December 2017 meeting when all critical personnel are present.

Adjourn: Motion was made to adjourn the November GCRGC board of directors meeting. Brad made the motion and seconded by Caleb: Motion carries.
