GCRGC Rule #10: Director Paul Kaczmarek makes a motion to amend Rule #10 to the following...

TARGETS – Only paper, cardboard and approved steel targets allowed. Steel targets placed on the Rifle Bays 1 to 4 must be at least 75 Yards from the front of the shooting benches. Steel “SPINNER” Targets are Prohibited on all GCRGC bays. Remove all targets and target frames brought to the range when finished shooting. Do not use glass

bottles, electronics, scrap metal, food items, ground targets or rocks as targets. Steel targets will not be engaged within thirty (30) feet.

The motion is seconded by Director Doug Argo and it carries. President Albaugh states the reasoning for the change is that shooting canted steel in rifle bays 1 & 2 will put ricochets into the pistol bays.

Electric Gate: Director Kaczmarek asks about needing a key card to enter and exit the gun range when the electric fence is installed. Director Kaczmarek was under the impression that the key did not have to be used to exit the range. President Albaugh explains the range will have a card reader for exiting the gun range as well as entering. Director Kaczmarek's concern was about people being left locked in the gate after matches and special events. President Albaugh states it is up to the match directors to ensure everyone is out.

Range Status: President Albaugh reports that the electrician has been great for the electric gate and should pass the inspection. After the inspection the gate people will take over. All backings are up for the rifle ranges and most of the shooting steel is in great shape. In general, the range is in good shape with some dirt work needing done on the parking lot in front of the rifle ranges. President Albaugh will move some dirt with his tractor in order for Secretary Bunting to put it in place with rakes and shovels.

Member Kurt Fuchs is concerned that as a GEM County member that he will not get a membership in the Club due to a lot of people applying. He is assured that there is no cut-off on membership for GEM County residents.
